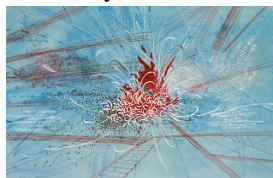

### Minutes of General Meeting, November 19, 2015 - Huntington Woods Library

**President Kathy O'Connell** called the meeting to order at 11:30 am. There were 42 members and guests present in the conference room of Huntington Woods Library.

The President thanked Jean Thomas and Richie Campbell for the plentiful hospitality table. New members and guests were welcomed.

**Recording Secretary Carolyn Sherwood** read the minutes of the October meeting. There were no additions or corrections. Madge Lawson made the motion to accept the minutes as read, supported by Paula Wild. Motion passed.

**Treasurer Marilyn Bomarito** reported an initial balance as of September 30 and, after October transactions, an ending balance as of October 31, 2015.

**Corresponding Secretary Joyce Manke** informed the membership that items to be included in the newsletter are due no later than the third week of the previous month. An updated fan out will be sent with the December newsletter.

**First VP Programs Deb Maiale** reported that the Program Committee has worked out well. Julie Strabel and Charlene O'Neill are co-chairs for the December 5th luncheon at City Kitchen. RSVP for this event if you plan to attend. There will be no silent auction; however, a \$500.00 donation will be made to Capuchin Missions Arts Outreach. Individual members may also make a contribution, but this is optional.

The Global Art Project exchange is being chaired by Carol LaChiusa and Beverly Zimmerman. Members need to contact the chairs if they are interested in taking part. Art should be no larger than 12" x 12". Work will be turned in at the February meeting. No work will be accepted after this time.

**Second VP Exhibitions Janet Kondziela** is chair of the Padzieski Gallery Show. Intake for entries is on February 18 which is also our regular Thursday meeting date. Entries will be dropped off at Padzieski Gallery at 10am. The Exec. Board will also meet at this time. The general meeting, intake of art for the Global Arts Project, and lunch will take place at Leon's, a restaurant two miles west of the Padzieski Gallery. After the general meeting Members will return to the gallery to pick up unaccepted work and/or attend the program which will be given by sculptor/juror Douglas Semivan. Art accepted for the Padzieski Gallery Show will also be exhibited at The Crooked Tree Gallery in Petoskey, MI in the summer of 2016. The June show will be at Anton Art Center. There will be a show at the CCS Gallery in the fall.

**Third VP Directory Arlene Oakland** informed the membership that the directory was not yet ready for distribution.

**Historian Julie Sabit** distributed resume forms to members who still need to turn in a brief biography and photo of work.
