Happy New Year! Our next meeting is February 18, 2016. That gives you extra time to prepare the art works you are going to enter in our March show at the Padzieski Gallery, Dearborn. Please note that our plans for our next meeting on February 18 have changed. All the day's activities will now be in the same building. Attention all board members: please plan to arrive between 9:30 and 9:45 to drop off your pre-entered artworks. We need you to all be in the conference before 10 a.m. because we will be starting the meeting on time.

Drop-off notes: If your work is heavy or hard to handle, you can park temporarily (with your flashers on) in the circle by the building's west entrance to unload your art and bring it into the gallery. Then move your car promptly to the adjacent parking lot. There are plenty of handicap parking spaces available. If you need assistance, just ask.

There has been a change in our exhibition line-up for 2016. Our exhibit at CCS has been postponed to 2017. Instead, we will have a Fall show at the Crooked Tree Gallery in Petoskey. This will NOT be a reprise of the March show but will be totally new. Jackie Rybinski has made all the arrangements so far. 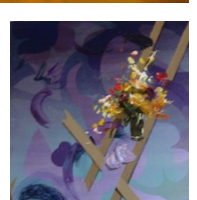

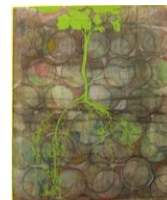
