President's Message:

Well, we thought it was going to be nail-biter, but we shouldn't have worried. Just hours before the deadline, Tracy Irwin received a flood of artist entries. (Although several more came in because of the e-mail blast.) We had 43 artists enter with 80 pieces in all. This time we also received several stunning sculptures. Tracy Irwin and Deb Benedict, as exhibit chairs, managed to prevail, despite many changes and setbacks, to produce a splendid show.

We did have one disappointment; due to unforeseen circumstances, Dominic Pangborn was unable to jury the artwork. Instead, Amy Corle, the Curator of Education and Public Engagement for the Museum of Contemporary Art in Detroit, was able to help us out (thus the artists were not kept waiting for the decisions. Dominic selected the award winners after viewing the accepted work.

The excellent news is that DSWPS will be included in a **New York Times** article on MOCAD and the exhibits of its winter season. The exhibits include: *The Architectural Imagination, Detroit Affinities: Adriana Martinez, Five Rings: Dana Hoey* and **HOME: Detroit Society of Women Painters and Sculptors.**

Saturday, February 11, 2017 is a shared reception for all 4 exhibitions 3 - 4 pm. DSWPS will have its own reception and award event in the Mike Kelley's *Mobile Homestead*.

We can continue to party there or we can attend the MOCAD Curator's talk and reception in the main building, 4 - 6 pm.

MOCAD's Opening Reception for the *general public is 6 - 9 pm (the Mobile Homestead will continue to be open until 9 pm as well).*

At 9 - 10 pm MOCAD will have a performance by The Black Opera. Admission to ALL the festivities before 9 pm is free.
