Message from the President:

Greetings to all! Hopefully you are preparing masterpieces for our upcoming show at the Padzieski Gallery.

Our next meeting is February 18 at 11:00 a.m., at the Ford Performing and Community Arts Center, in the same building as the Padzieski Gallery.

The Call-For-Entry is included with this newsletter. Be sure to read ALL of it carefully. Note that the postmark deadline for entries is February 12. **Art intake is February 18 at 10:00 a.m.** at the gallery. After delivering your artwork, head for the meeting room for some social time and a chance to look at the art brought in for the Global Art Project. If you are participating in the Global Art Project, remember to bring your art!

Attention all board members: special early drop-off time!

Drop off your pre-entered artwork between 9:30 and 9:45. We need board members to be in the conference before 10 a.m. because we will be starting the meeting on time.

Drop-off notes: If your work is heavy or hard to handle, you can park temporarily (with your flashers on) in the circle by the building's west entrance to unload your art and bring it into the gallery. Then move your car promptly to the adjacent parking lot. There are plenty of handicap parking spaces available. If you need assistance, just ask.

There have been more changes - or shall we say, refinements - to our exhibition line-up for 2016. We have decided those artworks that are selected by our juror, Hubert Massey for the June show at the Anton Art Center will also be eligible to be our Fall show at the Crooked Tree Gallery in Petoskey.

The Crooked Tree show is tentatively planned for mid September through mid November. Watch future newsletters for the significant updates on details of that show. We will need help with the logistics of transporting our art safely and inexpensively to Petoskey and assisting Crooked Tree as needed with intake and installation. Of course, we also need help bringing any unsold work home. If any of you can assist with this, please let Jackie Rybinski or me know.

Dara Brooks has been busily preparing to chair the June show at the Anton Art Center. Jurying will take place at the DYC during our May meetings. Details and a timeline for that show are elsewhere in this newsletter.

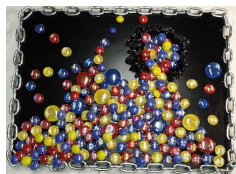

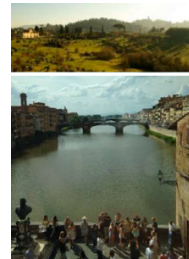
